## **OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY AND HEALTH ADMINISTRATION (OSHA)** INSPECTION PROCEDURES SHOW THEM HOW WE GET IT DONE...SAFELY.

The purpose of this plan is to describe the specific actions required

of employee-owners and subcontractor employees upon the arrival of an OSHA Compliance Officer at a Company workplace or jobsite to inspect facilities or equipment or to investigate related matters. It is the responsibility of the Department of Labor, Division of Occupational Safety and Health Administration to carry out compliance for Occupational Safety and Health. In this regard, Federal OSHA Compliance Safety and Health Officers carry out the enforcement and monitoring aspects of the Act. The OSH Act is applicable to all contractor organizations (including subcontractor activities/operations). The Company will review and evaluate this program on an annual basis, when changes occur to the regulations, when operational changes occur that require a revision of this document, when there is an accident or near-miss that relates to this area of safety, or any time fall protection procedures fail. **NOTICE OF AN OSHA INSPECTION**
